

New Membership Placards Available At Chamber Office

The good-looking metal placards in yellow and green bear the legend "Member Chamber of Commerce, Southern Pines, N. C. Designed to Protect and Promote the Interests of the Community."

They have a removable date feature which is practical as well as good-looking. The date "1953" on the placard indicates that dues for this year have been paid. When this date becomes obsolete, it may be removed and a metal "1954" inserted in its place. Dates for each year may be ordered at a minimum cost and the same

placards may thus be used for many years.
