### FHA Leaders Discuss Hurricane Loans At Local Meeting; Rangers Here Too

Personnel of Farmers Home Administration offices of 14 central and eastern counties, holding their quarterly meeting at the Southland Hotel here last week, found Hurricane Hazel high on the priority list of their discussion topics.

The agency had been asked by the State Department of Agriculture for fast action in processing disaster loans to farmers who suffered hurricane damage. H. J. Isenhower, state FHA director, at the local meeting, gave instructions for necessary steps in this project.

Irrigation loans to farmers had been previously scheduled as a top subject for the meeting, which brought 50 to 60 state FHA

officials and county staff members here, most of them checking in Wednesday night, for concentrated discussion sessions Thursday and Friday.

They came into the Southland on the heels of another important state agency, the N. C. Forest Service. Forest rangers, assistant rangers and personnel of the district office at Rockingham held their meeting Tuesday and Wednesday of last week, with state and district leaders as speakers. Ben E. Douglas, director of the State Department of Conservation and Development, was on the program Tuesday. Both the Rangers and the FHA group have met here several times before.

### MILK RECORD

Long Creek Lady, an 11-year-old registered Ayrshire in the herd of the North Carolina Sanatorium at McCain has completed an actual production record of

10,722 pounds of 4.6 per cent milk and 493 pounds of butterfat in 305 days on a strictly twice-a-day milking schedule. According to Chester C. Putney, Executive Secretary of the Ayrshire Breeders' Association, this record is

equal to 11,708 pounds of milk and 538 pounds of butterfat when figured to a Mature Equivalent basis. The record was made in accordance with the rules of the Ayrshire Herd Test Plan.

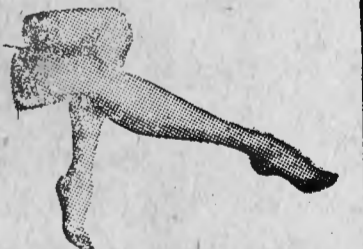
