C., who died March 1, 1954, was honored posthumously on January 25, as the "Outstanding Citizen" of Calhoun County for 1954. The widow of the Rev. Mr. McDonald, stated clerk of the Presbyterian Synod of South Carolina, received the award, which was presented at the annual Ladies Night banquet of the St. Matthews Lions Club. Mrs. McDonald, who lives in Columbia, is executive secretary of the South Carolina Tuberculosis Association. Calhoun County Senator L. Marion Gressette said in the presentation: "Dr. McDonald was selected for the annual award because he 'Lived in the hearts of the people of Calhoun County.'" Dr. McDonald served as pastor of St. Matthews Presbyterian Church since 1941, and was an active field worker for Presbyterian College and director of Columbia Community Chest. Senator Gressette characterized Dr. McDonald as "a wise and sympathetic counselor and a friend to mankind," saying that the late minister's influence had

been felt, not only by Presbyterians but by all citizens of Calhoun County. The Rev. Mr. McDonald was reared in Carthage, a son of the late Mr. and Mrs. J. H. McDonald. He was a brother of Miss Flora McDonald, county home agent, P. H. McDonald, and A. K. McDonald, of Star.
