Academy Heights School-\$25,-000 County Funds to supplement \$19,380.01 State Funds for Cafeteria and Home Economics Building; \$5,000 Equipment for Building; \$1,500 Renovation Classroom and Furniture for Library, a total of \$31,500.

It was pointed out that Academy Heights School did not have a cafeteria and that a new building would mean much to the school. Supt. Cannon mentioned that the enrollment in the Pinehurst School had increased 25 per cent during the past five years and all indications were that the enrollment would continue to increase.
