New Money Order Form To Be Used

A new money order form will be used in Southern Pines, starting Monday.

"To curb the raising of postal money orders, the Post Office Department has redesigned the money order form at first and second class post offices," Postmaster A. Garland Pierce announced today.

The purchaser's application will be discontinued when the new money order form is placed in use. In issuing the new form the amount requested by the purchaser will be written in the money blocks on the order, the purchaser's receipt and the post office stub, and then a rubber stamp impression will be inserted in a proper space to indicate the next higher amount in multiples of \$10.
