Junior Red Cross Donates \$100 To Hungarian Relief

Board directors of the American Red Cross chapter in Moore County were told Friday night that junior Red Cross members in the county had decided to donate \$100 for Hungarian relief, particularly for children in that country.

The announcement was made by Mrs. J. E. Causey, chairman of junior Red Cross work, as the Board of Directors held one of a series of orientation meetings at the Dixie Inn in Vass.

She said also that a number of articles had been made by members and would be shipped to Donaldson Air Force Base in Greenville, S. C. for distribution there.

Lynn Warren, Red Cross field representative, was principal speaker at the meeting, explaining the work of the international agency in disaster preparedness and relief.

Others appearing on the program were Mrs. Audrey Kennedy, executive secretary of the county chapter, who discussed home service and other activities available, and Donald Kennedy, fund chairman for 1957, who announced the drive would occur, as usual, in March. He urged the directors to begin thinking about the drive and start making their plans.
