

False Arrest Suit Asking \$25,000 Is Filed In US Court

A \$25,000 damage suit, charging false arrest, was on file in the U. S. Middle District Court in Greensboro this week against W. B. (Bill) May of Cumberland County and Jackson Motors, Inc., of Southern Pines.

The suit was brought by 1st Lt. Henry G. Haalck of Ft. Bragg, who lived in Southern Pines prior to his discharge from the Army last week.

Haalck contends that on September 17 May and Jackson Motors caused a warrant to be issued accusing him of obtaining a 1956 automobile from May under "false pretenses and malicious fraud." He claims further that he was "falsely arrested and detained" pending trial which "terminated in favor" of the officer when it was dismissed for lack of probable cause in Recorder's Court.

The original trial was held before Judge J. Vance Rowe, who found that there was no cause to further hold Haalck. The officer, who is now residing in Connecticut, was represented in court by W. D. Sabiston of Carthage. At the time of the trial he contended that a deal had never been consummated with May to purchase a new automobile.

May, on the other hand, said that Haalck had taken the new car and promised, as part of the deal, to turn over a used model to him at his used car lot near Fayetteville, a car he said was never produced.

In making judgment in the case Judge Rowe said that Haalck's conduct was reprehensible but that "a promise to pay is nothing legal."

Haalck, according to friends he had here, is planning to enter the Yale University School of Forestry.

It was understood at the trial that the only part that Jackson Motors played in the transaction was furnishing the new car to May for resale to Haalck.

The car was returned to May after the trial.
