

### Airborne Units Now At Mackall

Elements of the 101st Airborne Division from Fort Campbell, Ky., parachuted Tuesday into Camp Mackall, south of Aberdeen, to join in Sky Wave XI, the XVIII Airborne Corps command post exercise that got into full swing at noon Wednesday.

Tuesday's jumpers formed the second wave of 101st Division personnel arriving this week to participate in the exercise at Camp Mackall. The first contingent arrived at the exercise area Monday.

Sky Wave is the Corps' dress rehearsal for its participation in the third U. S. Army command post exercise "Lucky Charlie" scheduled for Fort Gordon, Ga., February 8-9. "Lucky Charlie" is a continuation of "Lucky Brave," held at Fort Gordon last year.

Also participating in Sky Wave will be the 82nd Airborne Division, XVIII Airborne Corps Artillery and other Corps subordinate units from Fort Bragg. The exercise, which winds up Friday afternoon, will be based on the combat situation to be used in Lucky Charlie, stressing the latest airborne doctrines and techniques.

### Name Changed To 'Podiatry Assn.'

Dr. D. W. Mann of Southern Pines reports that the name of a professional organization of which he is a member has been changed. The National Association of Chiropodists now officially become the "American Podiatry Association," Dr. Mann said.

### Rotarians Hear About Red Cross History, Work

Speaking to the Southern Pines Rotary Club on Friday, Brig. Gen. Lehman W. Miller, retired, told of the history and world-wide operations of the Red Cross, noting particularly the varied functions and variety of services of the American Red Cross.

General Miller, who heads the 1958 Moore County Red Cross membership campaign, formerly lived in Westminster, Md., where he was disaster preparedness relief chairman. He was vice-chairman of the Moore County drive last year.

Mrs. Audrey Kennedy, executive secretary of the Moore County Red Cross chapter, also was a guest of the club. Both Mrs. Kennedy and General Miller were introduced by Garland Pierce.

General Miller said that in his work with the Red Cross campaign last year, he had been surprised at the number of local citizens who appeared to have doubts in their minds about the value of the Red Cross.

The speaker then described in some detail the various Red Cross welfare services, with special attention to its aid to members of the armed forces, and the organization's disaster relief program.

He cited several major disasters—hurricanes and floods—in the years 1955-1957 in connection with which the Red Cross has spent \$50 million, depleting its funds. In hurricane Audrey relief alone, he said, the Red Cross has spent

\$2,500,000 to aid 4,330 families and rebuild for them homes and family-owned business buildings.

Government aid is responsible for help with business buildings other than those for "family-owned" businesses, he explained.

Founded in Switzerland in 1859, the Red Cross now operates in 57 nations of the world, General Miller said. The American Red Cross was chartered by the Federal government under a special act of 1905.

The President of the United States is also the president of the American Red Cross, he noted. The Red Cross has a board of 50 national directors, 12 of whom are appointed by the President.

Thirty directors are elected by delegates of local chapters, and then these 42 directors elect eight others, to complete the board of 50.

A \$1 membership in the Red Cross entitles the holder to vote for directors of a local chapter, General Miller pointed out. He emphasized that for every paid Red Cross worker, there are 134 volunteer workers.
