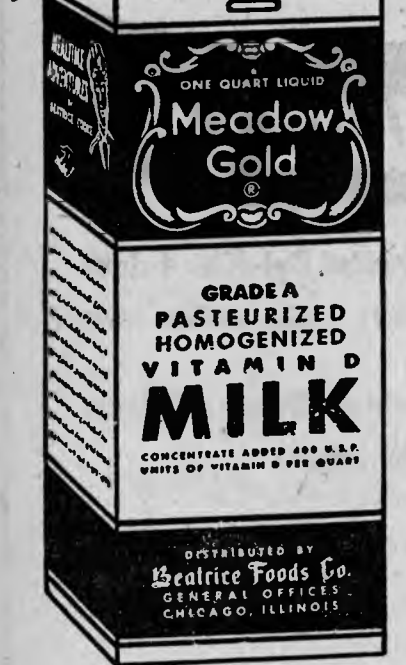


CARTHAGE NEWS

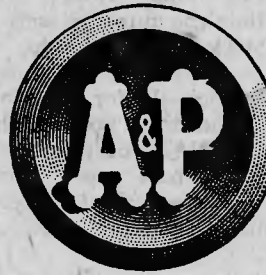
