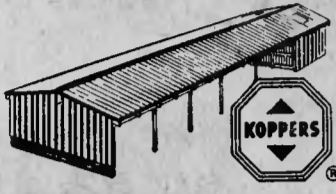


The 1960 output of newsprint—the paper upon which newspapers are printed—totaled 1,064,279 tons in 15 Southern states. This was more than half the national total of 2,003,845 tons.

PUTS COMMUNITY OVER QUOTA

Vass Scout Troop Raises Over \$100 With Fish Fry to Help Fund Drive

The achievement of Boy Scout Troop 810 of Vass in raising over \$100 by a fish supper Saturday night has put its community's Scout fund drive over the goal and has qualified the unit for membership in the Oconeechee Council's "Century Club"—the first time this designation has ever been won by a Scouting unit in Moore District.

Twenty of 27 boys in the troop took an active part in working on the supper, with assistance from ladies of the three Vass churches that sponsor the troop—Baptist, Methodist and Presbyterian—and mothers of the Scouts. The ladies furnished hushpuppies, cornbread,

pies and cakes to go with the 120 pounds of fish that were cooked and sold. Slaw was also served.

The supper was held at the community house. During the evening Charles Riddle of Southern Pines, Moore District Scout executive, and Roy McCallum of Raleigh, council field representative, put on a program about Scouting, showing a film and presenting other information.

Karl Schweinfurth, former Scoutmaster of the troop, was in charge of the supper project.

"Century Club" membership is a designation given to individuals or firms contributing \$100 or more to the annual fund drive for funds to operate the Scouting program in the 12-county Oconeechee Council of which Moore District is a part.

Scout officials expressed appreciation to Harold Williams, chairman of the troop committee of Troop 810, for the efforts of his committee in putting the Vass Scout fund drive over the top. Many donations were made by individuals. These contributions, combined with the more than \$100 raised by the supper, made Vass the first community in the county to exceed its quota in the current county-wide Boy Scout fund drive.

An enlarged reproduction of the Norman Rockwell painting, "The Scoutmaster" was given to the troop by the Council, in recognition of its efforts.

Wayne Kivett, the 15-year-old, Route 3, Raeford boy, who accidentally shot and killed a 15-year-old neighbor, Patricia Ann Capel, Saturday, is a former Sandhills resident, having lived at Niagara, before his family moved to Hoke County early this year. He attended the Southern Pines school.

The shooting victim also had Moore County connections. She was a granddaughter of Mrs. Ben Brady of Robbins.

According to news accounts of the tragedy, Kivett and a friend stopped at the girl's house on their way hunting. His shotgun, thought to be unloaded was pointed at the girl jokingly and the boy pulled the trigger.

The shooting was ruled accidental and no charges were made.

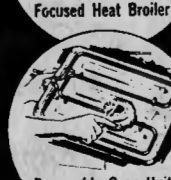
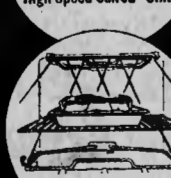
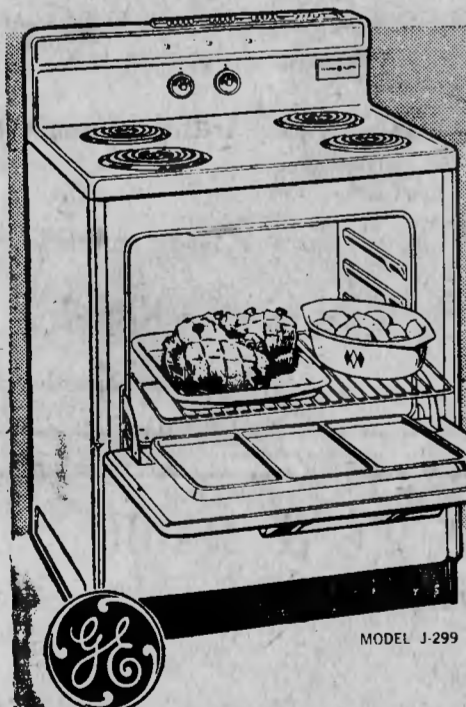
