SOUTHERN PINES RECORDER'S COURT

Several West Southern Pines boys appeared in Southern Pines Recorder's Court, at the regular Wednesday session last week, charged with breaking and entering or larceny or both.

The cases were disposed of as follows by Judge W. Harry Fulenwider

Olander McNeill, 16, charged with one case of breaking and entering and larceny (at the Town Hill Club), larceny of a record player from the West Southern Pines School and larceny of a bicycle, was sentenced to serve six months at the county jail in Carthage, to work in and around the jail. A six months sentence was given in each of the three cases, to run concurrently.

Walter Sloan, and John Allen McNeill, both 18, also charged in connection with the Town Hill Club break-in—when beer, cigarettes and various food items were taken—were each found not guilty. Both were on probation from former convictions and remain on probation.

Ronnie Douglas, 16, also charged with breaking and entering was found guilty and was sentenced to Morrison Training School, for a 15-months term.

The case of another boy, who was found to be under 16 years of age was remanded to Juvenile Judge C. C. Kennedy, clerk of court at Carthage. Names of juvenile defendants are not published.

Nancy Shaw Monroe, Pinehurst, failure to report as driver of vehicle involved in accident, \$10 and costs; Johnny Myers, Route 1, Sanford, larceny, not pros with leave; Willie Doyle Shuler, Orangeburg, S. C., speeding 70 in 55 zone, \$15 and costs; James Arthur Coar, San Francisco, Calif. speeding 65 in 55 zone, \$10 and costs; William Seaborn Smith, Tampa, Fla., speeding 60 in 45 zone, \$15 and costs; Henry Thomas France, non-support, defendant to pay half of his paycheck, through the court, to his wife for support of her and their children, payment to be made by 11 a. m. each Saturday, the court costs to be deducted from the defendant's share at a rate of \$2 per

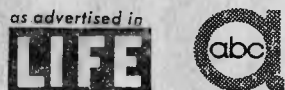
