Dear Sirs:—

It is time for us all to begin to learn how to make our FOOD at HOME and not be dependent on the North and West for our something to eat.

WHEAT

Every farmer should plant at least TWO ACRES IN WHEAT to each horse. After the wheat is harvested in the spring he can follow up with corn and make a good crop, or sow peas and make hay on the same land, and thereby make two crops.

CORN

Every farmer should plant enough land in corn so as to make enough for his own use and have some to spare and sell during the summer months, when money is scarce and hard for the farmer to get.

PEAS, POTATOES, HAY AND OATS

Should every farmer make enough of all the things mentioned above, and some to spare, they would not be ruined when the low prices come on cotton and tobacco, but would be independent and not owe more than they could pay when housing times come on.

Plant one-half the Tobacco and Cotton you have been planting and get the same dollars for it.
