Keep your eye on the right man in the political contest. There is plenty of time yet to do the voting.

Every few days there are rumors that a paper factory will be erected here, and of course, such a thing should be. But it would be more satisfactory if we could behold the building in course of erection. A paper factory in Williamston would be another case of "bitting the steel" for here's where we grow 'em to paper 'em.

During the month of January 10,429 749 lbs. of seed cotton were sold in the State, 4,311,600 lbs. above the sales for the corresponding period last year. Of the total sales during the month, Williamston sold 46,512 and Robersonville 20,480, making a total of 66,992 lbs. sold in the county. The prospects for a good year for the weed are very promising and our farmers would be safe in planting a crop.

If the fifty-one young men who received their licenses to practice law in the courts of North Carolina last week will but remain true to their profession, they will be a mighty force for good among this people. A true lawyer is an honor to any community. But it is a sad fact that too many men in the profession are simply after filthy lucre and so lose sight of their sworn obligation to uphold the laws of their State and Nation.

Topping Cotton

We have been furnished by J. H. Gurganus with figures of the result of cotton topping for the year 1911. This experiment was conducted on the farm of C. W. K. on the Hamilton Road under the directions of the State Department of Agriculture.

Every condition of soil, fertilizer and cultivation was the same. Mr. Gurganus began topping July 3rd, and topped one row every other day until August 8th. The result was that the untopped 18 rows produced 1175 lbs. of seed cotton against 1167 lbs. produced in the 18 rows topped. This would indicate that topping does not pay especially so in a dry year, when one of the principal things is to get a good growth of weed.

Prospects of a Road

The Raleigh Times of Tuesday contained the information that there were prospects of a railroad being built from Littleton to Hamilton. The news is good, for it will open up a fine section of Martin County and bring great things to Hamilton. The road would run from the Northern end of Halifax County through the towns of Brinkleville, Esfield, Scotland Neck, Palmyra on to Hamilton. A. Paul Kitchin who is very much interested in the matter, says that one proposition is that the people along the proposed route pay for the blueprints, which will cost \$5,000. Business men in Scotland Neck approve of the proposition and will do what they can to help the movement. The people of Hamilton, no doubt, will invest largely in anything which will help their town. It is hoped that the road will be built in the near future.

Use for German Peat. Peat deposits in northwest Germany are to be used as fuel for the development of electrical energy.
