**Large Percent Landless**

Taking the census of 1910, it is found that there are eleven hundred and eighty thousand people in North Carolina in town and country regions, who are landless and homeless; this is 52 per cent of the population. Dare comes first with the smallest percent (8.6) of rented homes and Scotland County last with the greatest or 77.8 percent of rented lands and homes. Martin County is 55th in the list with 51.1 percent of renters. This condition, perhaps, has been improved greatly, at least, in Martin, where so many people have purchased homes within the last five years.

**To Furnish Seed For Farmers**

Dr. John D. Biggs is heading a movement to secure seed for the farmers of Martin County, which is a progressive step along the proper and needed lines. Agent J. L. Holliday will assist Dr. Biggs in the movement for the help of the farmers, and it is proposed to secure \$10,000 to buy the seed. Anything that helps the farmer at this time, will aid the government in the stupendous task before it, and other leading men in the county should fill the ranks of those who are doing something to aid.
