There were, reported to me during the month of January, the following cases of disease: Measles, 95 cases. Scarlet fever, 3 cases. Diphtheria, 1 case—total 99 cases. Homes placarded, 71. Ninety of these cases were in the town of Williamston and were placarded within forty eight hours. The householders very kindly reported 20 cases; Dr. Saunders 27; Dr. York 3; Dr. Rhodes 10; Drs. OUR BONDED DEBT

The state bonds issued by North Carolina up to January 1st, are sixty nine million dollars all told, or nearly twenty seven dollars per inhabitant. The state bonded debt is right around half of what we have invested privately in automobiles alone. And the per capita burden of bonded debt is just a little more than half the cost of a set of Ford tires. The interest on the bonded debt of the state is \$2,800,000 a year, which is about a dollar per inhabitant, and a dollar is just about the cost of five gallons of gasoline. We buy cars and tires and gasoline, and never think of bankruptcy, but when we talk about state bonds,

we think about nothing else but bankruptcy. The state is far sicker to be bankrupted by private automobiles than by public bonds.

Learn the Government way to poison. For years the experts of the U. S. Department of Agriculture have been seeking a dependable and profitable way for the farmer to poison the boll weevil. After innumerable experiments and demonstrations, the Government announced the discovery of a method of poisoning with calcium arsenate, which, if properly done, will control the weevil and make cotton growing profitable in badly infested sections. The Government work has been carried on in the far South where the weevil first appeared and where the infestation is worst. But the weevil is in North Carolina now, and our farmers can save their cotton if they use the knowledge gained in Louisiana, Alabama and Mississippi. Like everyone else whose property is wrapped up in the growing of profitable crops, we are most anxious that Carolina farmers should be shown this Government method of poisoning before the weevil destroys our cotton. To help give the farmers first hand knowledge of the Government method of poisoning the weevil, we have employed one of the most experienced field demonstrators attached to the Government Laboratory at Tallulah, La., in which this method of poisoning was discovered. He will devote his whole time to demonstration work in North Carolina, and will conduct his work in conjunction with the county agents. This expert, Mr. J. O. Taylor, will demonstrate this method in 12 or 15 infested counties of North Carolina. Mr. Taylor's services are offered as a lecturer on poisoning at any farmers meeting in any part of the State, at no expense. He will, in addition, gladly advise any farmer who wishes to poison his own crop this season. All requests for his services should be made to the Farm Service Department, F. S. Royster Guano Company.
