MENDMENTS TO THE LAWS RELATIVE TO MORTGAGE

An Act to Facilitate the Examination of Titles and to Create a Presump tion of Payment of Instruments Se curing the Payment of Money After Fifteen Years From the Date of Maturity of the Debts Secured

The General Assembly of North Car

olina do enact:
Section 1. That section two thou sand five hundred and ninety four of the Consolidated Stautes of North sub-section, as follows:

ortgage, deed of trust, or other intrument securing the payment of oney shall be conclusively presum d to have been complied with or the lebt secured thereby paid, as against reditors or purchasers for a valuade consideration from the trustor, nortgagor, or grantor, from and after the expiration of fifteen years rom the date when the conditions of uch instrument by the terms thereof re due to have been complied with. or the maturity of the last installment of debt or interest secured thereby, nless the holder of the indebtedness econed by such instrument or party ecured by any provision thereof shall file an affidavit with the register of eeds of the county where such intrument is registered, in which shall be specially stated the amount of debt unpaid which is secured by said instrument or in what respect any othr condition thereof shall not have been complied with whereupon the register of deeds shall record such Midavit and refer on the margin of the record of the instrument referred o therein the fact of the fling of uch affidavit, and a reference to the book and page where it is recorded. Or, in lieu of such affidavit, the holder my enter on the margin of the recrd any payments that have been nade on the indebtedness, secured by uch instrument, and shall in such en ry state the amount still due there y the holder and witnessed by the egister of deeds: Provided, howev r. that this sub-section shall not apdy to any weed, mortgage, deed or or other instrument made iven by a y railroad company, or to greement of conditional sale equipcent trust agreement, lease, chattel nortgage, or other instrument relatng to the sale, purchase; or lease of ailroad equipment or rolling stock, or of other personal property. In case of foreclosure of

my deed of trust or mortgage, the rustee or mortgagee shall enter upon he margin of the record thereof the act of such foreclosure and the date when, and the person to whom, a coneyance was made by reason thereof.


