Manners and the Motor. The Victorian era undoubtedly had its faults but its manners had taken away a few things which the world would do better to retain.

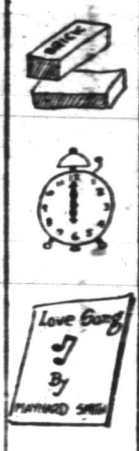

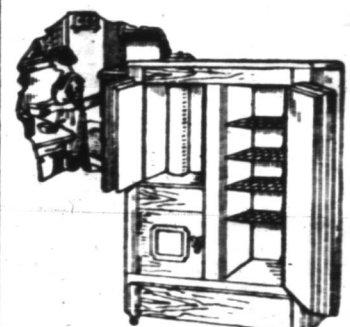
