Negro To Be Given Hearing Monday on Murder Charge

Ben Scott, now recovering in a Washington hospital from an attack of pneumonia, will be returned here probably next Monday for a preliminary hearing in connection with the murder of Henry Lanier, colored man, here the 17th of last month. Scott who has been in the hospital for about ten days will face Justice J. L. Hassell about next Tuesday.

No new evidence in the killing has been uncovered by investigating officers, Scott vigorously denying the charge, and Willie Melton, young negro, still claiming he saw Scott shoot Lanier.
