Allies Lost 4,773 Ships During War

The Axis sank 4,773 Allied merchant ships weighing 21,141,000 tons in desperate air-sea attempts to cut wartime supply lines, the navy announced in Washington a few days ago.

Losses of Allied merchant ships due to Axis action increased from 215 in 1939 to a high of 1,573 in 1942. Cargo ships destruction in 1940 totaled 986 ships; 1941, 1,118; 1942, 595; 1944, 198, and 1945, 88.
