#### Will It Be Cut And Dried?

The opening of North Carolina's 1947 General Assembly this week is causing little concern and attracting next to no attention from the public, generally. The body, more or less august, has long followed a cut-anddried policy, and some are asking will it repeat its past performances.

Back in the thirties, a sales tax was imposed as the last resort to head off financial failure. It was described as an emergency measure. The emergency has long since past, but the tax is still with us. It has been altered, to be sure, but the old cut-and-dried policy is to still hang on to the tax.

Is the fate of these and similar issues already sealed? Will they be aired in the light of progress, or will they be given the runaround? These are timely questions, and how they are answered will, no doubt, have bearing on the future of the Democratic Party in North Carolina.
