

Officials Solve Butterfly Case

The London mystery of the missing butterflies, replete with Scotland Yard sleuths and international angles, has been cleared up.

Colin Wyatt, 36, British, was encouraged by his interest in the collection of butterflies, stole them.

Wyatt pleaded guilty to charges of stealing more than 600 rare Australian butterfly specimens from a Melbourne museum and 1500 more from a Sydney museum last December.

He said he lifted the butterflies which experts said were priceless, because that seemed the perfect way to keep his mind off the fact that his wife had walked out on him.

A sympathetic court fined Wyatt \$400 after hearing how his "perfect marriage" broke up after his discharge from the Royal Australian Air Force.

Scotland Yard inquiries leading to Australia, New Zealand and the U. S. A. ended in Wyatt's home in Surrey near London a month after the butterflies disappeared.

educated Wyatt was a collection of 40,000 butterflies. Yard officials, using "butterfly wingprints" from Australia instead of fingerprints, identified the stolen specimens.
