Local Firm Will Handle Jet Curers

The Farmers Supply Co. of Williamston has been appointed as distributor in this area for the AMF Jet Tobacco Curer, which uses the new principle of jet combustion to cure tobacco automatically and economically.

In contrast to curers familiar to tobacco growers, the AMF Jet Tobacco Curer requires no exhaust flues in the barn, because it produces virtually no smoke or soot or other ordinary products of oil combustion. Engineers of the American Machine and Foundry Company, who spent three years developing the unit, have found that from 98 to 99 percent of all the heat value in the oil is extracted.

Throughout the test period, which is now entering its fourth year, the AMF Jet Curer has been used by practical tobacco growers throughout the flue-cured belt. Farmers have reported fuel savings of from 30 to 50 percent or more, with "average" barns requiring from 75 to 100 gallons of No. 2 fuel oil, somewhat less expensive than the kerosene in common use.

Oak City Soldier To Take Special Course

Corporal Ernest Barfield, Detachment "B", 8031st Regional Post Engineer Service Unit, will soon depart for the Air Transportability Training Center where he

will attend the Cadre Course. This course is designed to teach the correct manner of loading and unloading both men and equipment for transportation by air.

Stationed in Yokohama, Japan's major port city and seat of headquarters of the Eighth Army, Corporal Barfield fills an essential assignment with the Army's Occupational Forces here as a supervisor of indigenous personnel in the crating section. This section is responsible for the packing and crating of the belongings of Occupational Personnel departing for the United States for reassignment.

Safety features include an "electric eye", which shuts off the unit automatically if the spark ignition is interrupted. A fusible link also stops operation of the curer if the barn temperature rises above curing levels. A standard, 1-3 horsepower electric motor supplies the power.

The AMF Jet Curer is being marketed through the American Machine Development Corporation, an subsidiary, with offices in Richmond and Raleigh.
