

Illegal Aliens In the Country

Recently it was announced that the Senate Appropriations sub-committee had been told several weeks ago that there are probably several million aliens who are in the United States illegally. The figure, two to five million, was vouched for by Director J. Edgar Hoover of the Federal Bureau of Investigation. At the same time Watson E. Miller, commissioner of immigration and naturalization, stated that over forty million aliens cross and re-cross the U. S. borders each year. "The exact total for 1949 was 40,077,000," Commissioner Miller said. He admitted that no one can be sure how many of these aliens are still in this country illegally after crossing the border. So far this year, officials have apprehended 200,000 of them. Assistants of the commissioner told the Senate sub-committee that at least two years would be necessary to clean up the load of illegal aliens within our borders, even if 800 additional men were placed on patrol on the borders of Mexico and Canada. The Canadian border is 4,000 miles long and is guarded by a patrol force of only 236 men. Commissioner Miller asked for new legislation which would give immigration officials the authority to apprehend and deport the thousands of aliens who enter illegally. Present laws he said are completely inadequate.

Lime For Pastures Should Be On Soon

Farmers who have not already applied lime on land to be seeded to pasture this fall, should start applying in now, according to W. W. Woodhouse, Jr., soil fertility scientist with the North Carolina Experiment Station. This is an important step for those farmers who plan to take part in the "Green Pastures" campaign. Most North Carolina soils should be limed to grow Ladino clover, says Woodhouse. While the work on the lime needs of Ladino has not been under way very long in this State, it appears that the plant is not too hard to satisfy. It is less exacting than alfalfa in this respect, says the scientist. On a soil which was very acid says Woodhouse, one ton of ground limestone produced good results during two years of testing. Above that rate, the returns per ton of limestone were barely noticeable. Liming for Ladino clover is necessary and profitable, but there is no reason to believe that a high rate of lime or frequent applications are required. Ladino seeded in 1948 responded well to a one-ton application of limestone made in 1938. The best guide is a soil test.

Increase In Food Production Noted

A 20 per cent per acre increase in the world's food crops is seen as a possibility as the result of research now going on at the California Institute of Technology. The tests, being conducted at Pasadena, have been made in greenhouses and laboratories where all natural weather and light conditions are exactly reproduced. It has been discovered that some plants grow almost as fast at night, under satisfactory temperatures, as during the day. City smog was found to unfavorably affect vegetable growth and sizes of crops. In Hawaii night lighting of sugar cane fields has increased yields and under ideal conditions sugar beet crops might be doubled or tripled the researchers say.

Consumption Of Cotton Increases

Domestic mill consumption of cotton this season has been higher than in 1948-49 and is expected to total about 8.5 million bales, as compared to 7.8 million last year. Exports of raw cotton are also running higher, and prospects are that they will reach 5.1-4 million bales as contrasted with 4.3-4 million last year. Rising cotton prices have resulted in a considerable amount of repayment of CCC cotton loans. Nearly half of the 3.2 million bales of 1949-crop cotton placed under loan has now been redeemed. Cotton acreage in this District in 1950 will be down about 9 per cent. More effective boll weevil control and higher yields may offset most of this reduction.

Increase Reported In Livestock Price

A stronger demand for meat pushed livestock prices up in May and early June. Hog prices are now running about \$4.00 above the low reached last December. Prices of better grades of cattle are also up sharply and are mostly \$3.00 to \$4.00 higher than at this time last year. Meat production in the first half of 1950 was about 2 per cent higher than in 1949. Most of the increase was in pork, while beef production was lower. Since more cattle are now on feed than last year and some 6 per cent more sows were farrowed this spring, meat production in the next six months should be larger. Prices of hogs, better grades of beef cattle, and meat, however, should be mostly steady to higher until late August or September when supplies start to increase seasonally. If urban business activity continues at its present high level, the seasonal decline in livestock and meat prices this fall may be less than usual.

Demand Strong For Tobacco Leaf

Price support for flue-cured and Burley tobacco will be higher than in 1949, and average prices received by growers may be above last year. Cigarette exports are declining, but most of the decrease has been offset by a higher consumption of cigarettes in this country. Consumption for the year ending July 1, 1950 may be around 355 billion—the highest on record. Exports prospects are more uncertain, but exports of unmanufactured tobacco from the United States in 1950 will probably not equal the 1949 total of 498 million pounds. Generally, export prospects for cigarette leaf are better than for dark tobaccos. Forests occupy over 18 million acres, 59 per cent of the total area of North Carolina.
