### Farm Trainees Visit Test Farm

Members of the Veteran Farmer Training Program at Jamesville, Oak City and Robersonville attended a Peanut Field Day at the Rocky Mount Experiment Station on Wednesday of last week. The field day was arranged by members of the staff of the State Department for Veteran Farmer Training in cooperation with the experiment station staff and the Extension Service. Much interest has been created in recent years in peanut experiment work due to the small yield and the increase in diseases of peanuts.

Several stops were made over the station where experts gave up to date information on that particular phase of the work being done to improve the production of peanuts and to control weeds, diseases and insects. Some very interesting work is being done to develop new varieties which promise to give a great increase in yield. In about two years some of these new varieties will very likely be available to the farmers to plant. While work has been done on peanut fertilization for several years very little work has been done towards developing new varieties and as a result the same varieties are being planted now that were planted fifty years ago, except they are in a more run down condition now.

Even though a great deal of work is being done on peanuts it will be several years before much progress can be seen. In the meantime each farmer can improve his present stock of peanuts by carefully selecting his seed peanuts and applying the best cultural practices that are recommended.
