The membership fee for adults is \$5.00, plus tax and for students, \$2.50, plus tax.

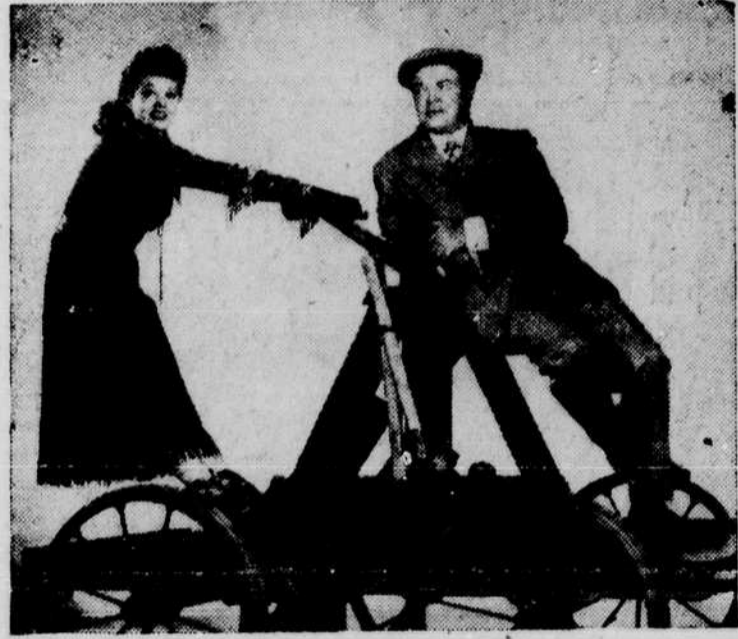
