# **Service Centers** Reject Thousands

The Army rejected 100,413 of he 207,038 men examined for the draft in August. This 48.5 per ent rejection rate compares with 52.2 per cent in July, when only 12,281 were given preinduction tests. In August, 20.1 per cent failed to pass the physical examnation, as compared with 26.8 per cent in July. The number failng to pass the intelligence test increased from 15.2 per cent in July to 17.6 in August.
