Mr. Baruch added: "We certainly must continue to strengthen the role played by our teachers in our schools. Education will help our citizens to distinguish between truth and falsehood, and thus better our chances for free-

General Eisenhower said, "To neglect our school system would be a crime against the future. Such neglect could well be more disastrous to all our freedoms than the most formidable armed assault on our physical defenses."

"The lowering totalitarian menace on the international horizon must not blur our perspective. America will arm itself and survive. But the gravity of our problems and the resolution required to end them emphasizes again that our cheif resource is the American citizen's intelligence and understanding readiness and capacity to do his full duty


