### Predisposition To Poliomyelitis

Predisposition to Infantile Paralysis is a result of a disturbance of a glandular balance in the afflicted, according to a statement by Dr. Gregory Schwartzman, of Mount Sinai Hospital in New York, in a story by William L. Laurence in the New York Times on January 24. Experiments with animals—Swiss mice and hamsters—indicate that the adrenal-gland hormone, cortisone, greatly enhances the susceptibility of the animal to the polio virus. In addition, the tests showed that some mysterious anticortisone factor counteracts the enhancing effect of cortisone in the development of polio. It is felt that when this mysterious anticortisone factor is identified, a means of restoring the disturbed balance in the adrenal-gland secretions for the prevention of polio will be discovered.
