

### Future Farmers Expert Judges

On Saturday, April 28, The Coastal Federation Livestock Judging Contest was held at the N. C. Tidewater Experiment Station near Roper. F. F. A. Departments in 3 counties, Martin, Washington, and Tyrrell, participated in the contest. There were 3 classes of livestock to be judged — Dairy cattle, Beef Cattle, and swine. Robersonville F. F. A. members walked away with top honors, scoring a total of 757 points out of a possible 900.

Members of the Robersonville chapter participating in the contest were:

Dairy team - C. L. Keel, Dan Clark, and A. P. Curtis who led with 36 points out of a possible 200.

The same team judged beef and swine. The members composing this team were C. L. Crawford, George James, and Billy Wynn who was top man with 187 points out of a possible 200. Ellis Haislip was an alternate and made a very high score for himself.

As result of these students efforts and achievements, they have earned the opportunity to enter the District Livestock Judging Contest which will be held in Tarboro in the latter part of May. Three separate teams will represent the Robersonville Chapter — one in Dairy Judging, another in Beef Judging, and the other in Swine.

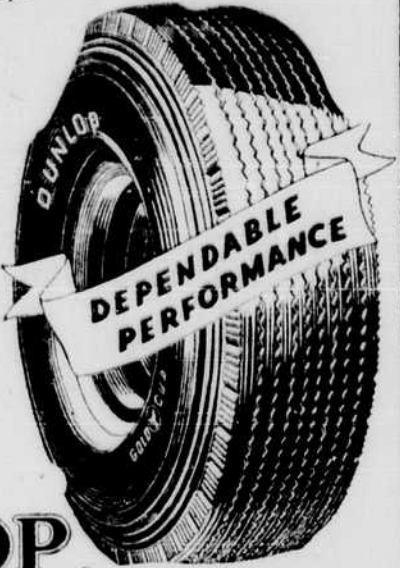

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### Many Ministers Lost In Korea

Religious News Service reports that four hundred and eighty native pastors, Protestant and Roman Catholic, have "vanished" under the North Korean regime. The report made by Rev. Edward Adams, Presbyterian field secretary in Korea, said he based his figure on reports collected by church headquarters in the United States. "It began under the Russians," he said, "and when they pulled out the North Korean government continued with it. First the pastors were asked to sign pledges supporting the North Korean government. Then many of them were told to give only one service a week. Children were told not to attend Sunday school. They seemed far more concerned with the children than with the old people."

### Farm Dwellers Dislike Hillbilly

Hamilton, O.—(UP)—It may come as a shock to some radio program directors, but the folks on the farm prefer semi-classical music to hillbilly tunes.

At least that is what Mrs. Iva Nicholson Williams found out when she questioned 255 farmers attending a conference of the Ohio Grange.

Mrs. Williams asked the Grangers: "Do you think rural people as a whole prefer hillbilly music?"

Their answer was 206 no, 36 yes, and 13 no opinion.

She then asked, "If you could listen to only one type of music which would you choose?"

The answers showed 65 favoring semi-classical music, 60 preferred old popular tunes, 59 liked sacred songs, 40 voted for modern dance music, seven gave hillbilly tunes the nod, six voted for western melodies, six said classical and 12 had no preference.

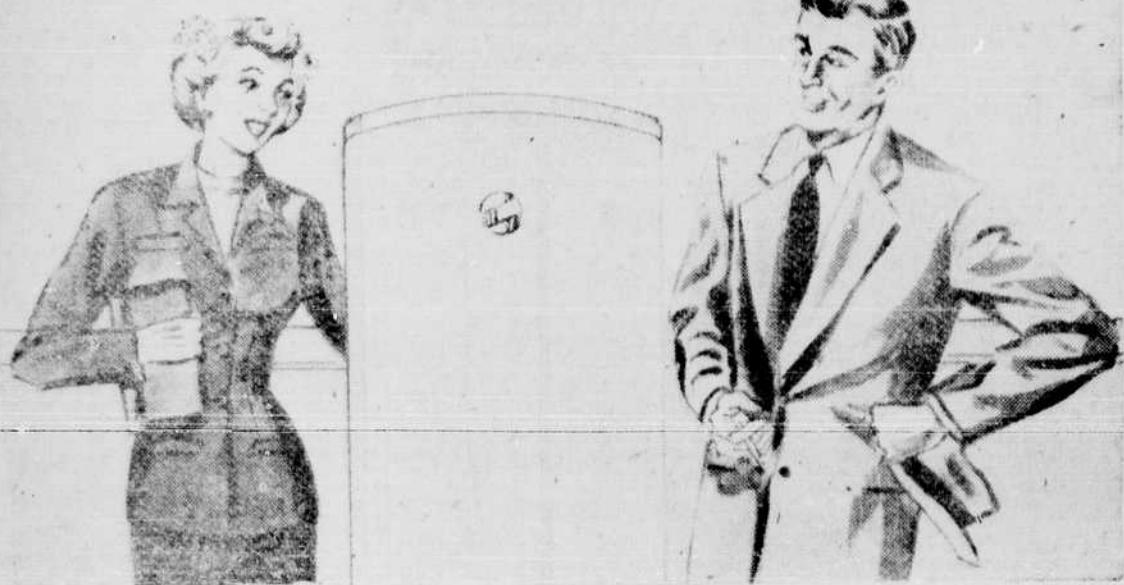
