ed 99.99 percent of the accidents would be stopped. He then went on to warn drinkers to stay from under the steering wheel. "You might be unable to stop drinking, but you are able to stay from under the steering wheel," he declared. And he warned that appeals from lower court judgments did not always pay. "There was a man who appealed from the prescribed judgment, and then was sentenced to the rocks for eighteen months. Then there was another man who got clear of a drunken driving charge, but later was booked for manslaughter," the jurist said.

The jurist admitted he did not know what to do to solve the serious problem. He declared that we have the finest patrol in the nation with the possibility that there is a "squirrel" or two here and there, and that there are good sheriffs and that most towns have good officers, but "if there are 5,000 patrolmen, they couldn't watch everyone," he said. According to the jurist the only hope is found in the repeated appeals for sanity and a determined drive against the foolish use of motor vehicles. "We must make people stop and think and use common sense and their brains. The laws are all right, the jurist saying that if they were obey-
