

Third Of A Million Home Fires in The Nation Each Year

Fires Take 5,000 Lives and Cause Loss Estimated At \$176,000,000

Home owners and tenants who have not experienced a dwelling fire of some kind in the past five years may consider themselves good "fire managers." It is an essential skill which everyone should acquire.

"Fire Management," according to the Institute for Safer Living is the practice of taking necessary measures to prevent fires in any home or dwelling for which you may be responsible. Lack of proper fire prevention knowledge, lack of interest, and lack of orderly habits are faults which contribute to more than 353,000 home fires annually, with 5,000 lives lost each year! many thousands of injuries, and an estimated \$176,000,000 in home property loss.

The basic steps in good "fire management," says the Institute are to eliminate the seven leading causes of home fires, and afterwards keep a continuing check on the premises to make sure that future hazards do not develop. The seven most frequent causes listed by the Institute are: 1. Failure to keep homes free of rubbish and improperly stored materials. 2. Failure to eliminate defects in chimneys. 3. Failure to take proper fire proofing measures for roofs. 4. Failure to keep home heating apparatus in safe operating condition. 5. Failure to use proper care in smoking and disposal of burning matches. 6. Failure to avoid improper use of gasoline, kerosene, and other flammable cleaning fluids. 7. Failure to use electrical equipment properly or failure to keep it properly repaired.

A few points to remember in your role as "fire manager" are: Provide a covered fireproof container for all flammable wastes and rubbish. Frequently inspect attic, cellar, and closets to prevent rubbish collections. Rubbish should not be burned at home unless you have a metal or heavy wire incinerator. Place stoves and heaters well away from walls and wooden fixtures. Nearby woodwork is best protected with sheet metal or asbestos. Protect the fireplace with spark proof screens. Oil burning units should have the approval of the Underwriter's Laboratory.

Dry leaves and litter frequently collect in gutters, drain spouts, and roof corners. Remove often. Unless you are an expert electrician, you take your life and property in your hands when you attempt to do home wiring or repair defective appliances. These jobs are strictly for the professional electrician.

Cultivate safe smoking habits by carefully disposing of cigar and cigarette stubs. Keep an ample supply of ash trays handy. Never smoke while you may fall asleep.

Roofs demand frequent inspection to eliminate fire hazards. Fireproof shingles are today's required roofing material, while a

metal or asbestos fire guard should be installed around chimneys. The chimney flue itself may develop cracks and often leaks or joints and should be carefully inspected each fall before use, along with the stove or furnace.

Finally, says the Institute, be prepared for a fire if it does come. Have family fire drills and plan in advance the best means of avoiding panic, evacuating occupants, and notifying the fire department. Keep an approved home fire extinguisher handy for putting out small fires.
