that will wreck the country," the speaker maintained.

Referring to the present plight of the Republicans, Mr. Morrison said they have no platform and no issues, but they say they have a hero. The speaker went on to explain that Mr. Eisenhower, with Dewey on one arm and Taft on the other, is wrapped up in Republican tradition, and "it does not bid well for the country."

The Republicans, he declared, are stubborn and are determined to stand by old traditions, including "hard" dollars. "You know, Woodrow Wilson once said that the Republicans had not had a new idea in forty years, and I know they have had none since Wilson said that," Mr. Morrison said, asking if the people wanted to be deflated and have everything knocked down.

Touching on the stealing in Washington, Morrison said there had been some irregularities, to be sure, but that the robbers had been ferreted out and prosecuted, that the Democratic Party hasn't one-tenth as many scoundrels in it as the Republican Party has.

He explained that Truman is not a candidate in the present campaign, but they have vilified and attacked him.

"We have not agreed with the President on all things, and with men like Herbert Bonner representing us, Truman did not get those things," Morrison said.

The old party warrior then turned again on the Republicans, declaring that they had come South with the promise of cancelling the mortgage held by the Democrats on this part of the country. "They come to us empty handed, I tell you. When nominating time was reached at Chicago, the Republicans went north and west. And they picked a vice president who they wish was not on their hands," Morrison said, declaring Nixon was the smallest man ever to run on any ticket. "He is full of conceit and emotionalism," he maintained.

"If the Republicans were really interested in the South, why didn't they offer it the vice presidency, at least?" Mr. Morrison asked.

Referring to the Democratic national ticket, the speaker declared that the South had a friend in Adlai Stevenson who he ranked as a peer of Woodrow Wilson and Franklin Roosevelt. "He is a great man, a man of integrity, and Sparkman, his running mate, is a southern statesman," the man from Mecklenburg said.

Going back to the olden days, Mr. Morrison recalled the contempt held for government under the Republicans. "No one had any respect for it," he declared.

Concluding his 30-minute talk, Mr. Morrison said, "I have no hope for future favors, for I have been favored in the past and for those favors I am deeply grateful, but you have a future, and I plead with you not to let the Republicans get back in power and wreck the economy of the country and your future. I appeal to you as an old man to rally under the Democratic banner from the President on down and carry it to victory on November 4."

Mayor Robt H. Cowen, in a few words, welcomed the visitors to Williamston, and called upon Attorney E. S. Peel who first introduced Congressman Herbert Bonner and then the main speaker, Congressman Bonner briefly addressed the group, stating that we had a good government and that to keep good government we must continue to elect good men and they are Democrats.

Governor Morrison left immediately after the event for Washington where he talked again last night. He was to be in Robersonville this afternoon for the district rally, but he received a call.

Collect Sixty-Five Billion In A Year

Federal tax collections in the fiscal year ending June 30, 1952, reached a new high record of \$65,009,585,000, according to figures just made public by the Bureau of Internal Revenue. This was \$415 for every man, woman and child in the nation. The total figure contrasts with the previous high collection of \$50,445,000,000 in the fiscal year ending June 30, 1951. Notwithstanding the record sum, collected in 1952, the government still spent about \$4,000,000,000 more than it collected.

The figures showed that corporation income and profit taxes and individual income levies amounted to more than \$55,000,000,000 last year, with the remaining \$10,000,000,000 coming from all other sources of federal taxes. More than half of the 1952 total — \$33,700,000,000 — came from individual income taxes.

Figure includes unemployment insurance collections. Individual income, social security and railroad retirement collections. Individual income levies showed a \$7,900,000,000 increase over the previous year.

New York led all the states in federal tax payments with a record of \$12,300,000,000, or about nineteen percent of the total. Other heavy tax-paying states were Illinois, \$5,380,000,000; Pennsylvania, \$5,123,000,000; Michigan, \$5,090,000,000; and California, \$4,645,000,000.

The report said it would be cheaper to rehabilitate the alcoholics than to put them in jail or try to ignore them. It warned the national governments that "protective measures should not be underestimated" and added that progress in reducing the number could best be attained by a "large-scale rehabilitation effort."
