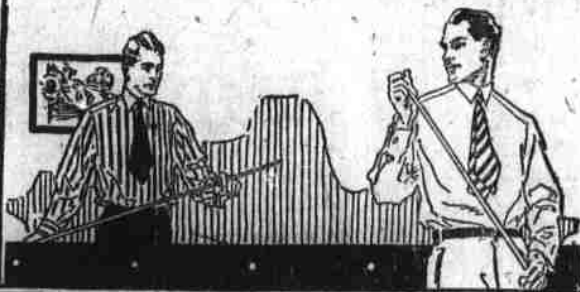

ORDINANCE.

No stock, geese, chickens, pigeons or other fowls shall be allowed to go at large, under a penalty of ten (\$10.00) dollars for each day. Stock, geese or fowls running at large shall be impounded by the police, and shall pay one (\$1.00) dollar a day as costs; if not paid in three days, said stock or fowls shall be sold at public auction for cash after five days' notice at three public places in the city, and proceeds paid to the owners less said costs and fines. Any person unlawfully taking any animal or fowl from the pound shall pay a fine of ten (\$10.00) dollars.

The above ordinance was adopted at a regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Tarboro, N. C., March 8th, 1920.

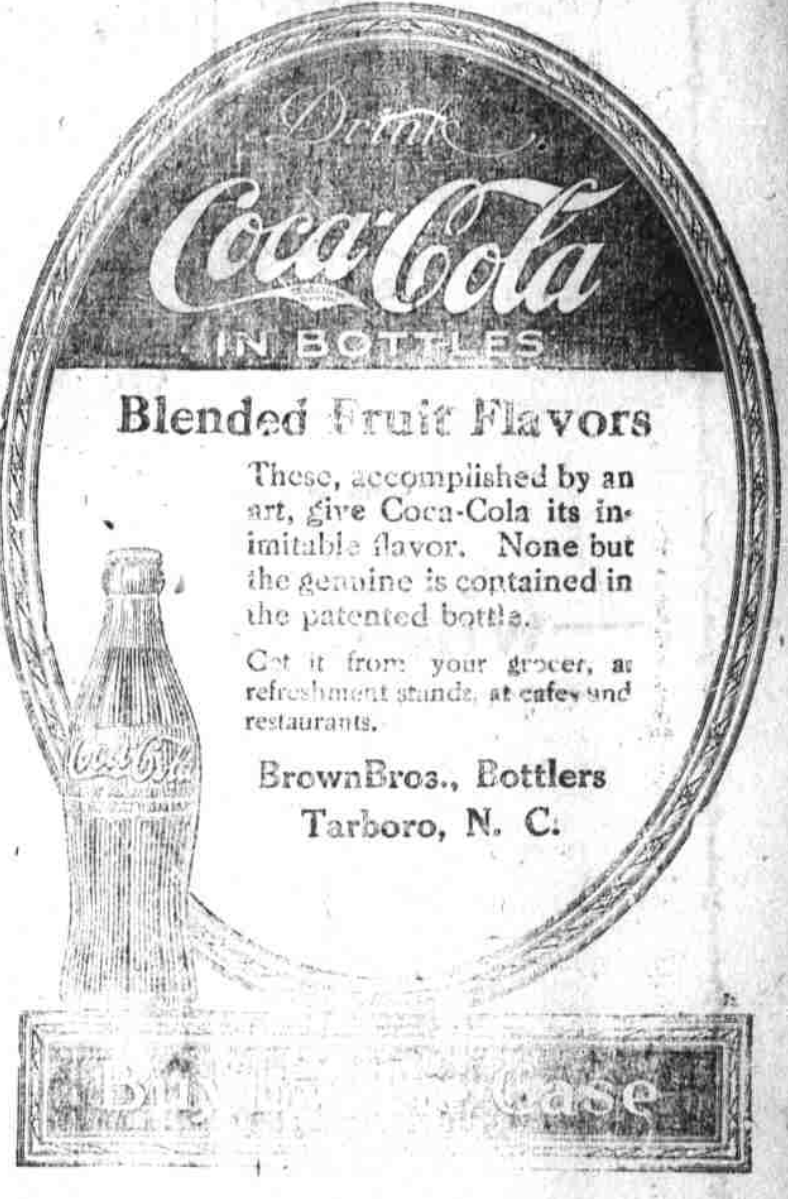
