

SPECIAL ELECTION CALLED FOR MACCLESFIELD SCHOOL DISTRICT

Upon the petition of the County Board of Education presented this day to the Board of County Commismissioners it is hereby ordered that a special election be held in the Macclesfield Special School district to ascertain the will of the people of the said district as to whether there shall be issued for the said district, bonds in the amount of \$25,000 for the purterest on the bonds to be six percent payable semi-annually and the length of time the bonds are to run shall

be twenty years. . It is further ordered that the said election be held on Tuesday the eleventh day of May, 1920, with polling place at Macclesfield; that the registration for the said election be opened on Monday, April 19, 1950, and closed at sunset on Saturday, May 8, 1920; and that at said election those favoring the issuing of the said bonds shall vote a printed or written ballot containing the words "For Schoolhouse Bonds" and those opposed shall vote a like ballot containing the words "Against School
