NEW ORLEANS OBSERVES ANNIVERSARY OF EADS

New Orleans, May 28.—New Orleans informally observed May 23 the 100th anniversary of the birth of James Buchanan Eads, the man responsible for the jetties at "Passes," installation of which made it possible to successfully navigate the mouth of the Mississippi river with sea-going vessels. The jetties narrowed up the channel and forced the river to carry its silt out to sea instead of choking up the passage. He was born May 23, 1820, in Lawrenceburg, Ind. Among other famous engineering feats was his construction of the Eads bridge at St. Louis.
