CATHEDRAL AT SAVANNAH TO BE DEDICATED JUNE 3

Savannah, Ga., May 21.—The Cathedral of St. John the Baptist, said to be the handsomest Catholic church between Baltimore and New Orleans, is to be consecrated June 3 with appropriate ceremonies. Bishop Gunn of Natchez, Miss., is to consecrate the building. The principal address will be delivered by Archbishop Glennon of St. Louis. Bishop Kelley, of Savannah, has charge of the cathedral, which stands at the corner of Abercorn and Harris streets. It was partly burned 21 years ago, was rebuilt even more elaborately than it stood originally.

Electric Light Rules and Regulations

That the following rates and rules for current consumed shall be in effect from and after June 1st, 1920:

Electric Light Rates.

All bills payable first of each month at office of City Clerk.

Flat rates:

2 cents per watt connected load.

Meter rates:

15c per K. W. hour.

Minimum charge of \$1.50 for 10 K. W. hours subject to 5 per cent discount.

10 to 24 K. W. hours at 15 cents; 5 per cent discount.

25 to 99 K. W. hours at 15 cents; 10 per cent discount.

100 to 199 K. W. hours at 15c; 15 per cent discount.

200 to 399 K. W. hours at 15c; 20 per cent discount.

400 K. W. hours and over at 15c; 25 per cent discount.

No discount allowed on bills unless paid on or before the 10th of month. In case rent is not paid on or before the 15th of month, the superintendent shall have the current cut out of such premises until said rent is paid in full, and in addition a charge of \$2.00 for cutting out and turning on current.

The above rates were adopted at a regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the town of Tarboro, N. C., on May 10th, 1920.
