been made by the Fisheties Commission Board.

Any person or persons redefaring moving, injuring or in any way dis urbing the posts, buoys, or any other ap pliances used by the Fisheries Commission in marketing the restricted areas relating to any and all fishing, or marking other areas in which oyster tonging or dridging is prohib ited by law, and those marking oyster bottoms time are leased for oyster cultivations, and, upon conviction, shall be fined or imprisoned.

Any person who shall catch any edible fish in the waters of the State of North Carolina for any other purpose than as food. and any person, firm or corpor ation who shall use any edible fish for fertilizing purposes shall be guilty of misdemeanor.
