Before beer may be sold, the dealer must file an application before the Board of Commissioners, setting forth his claim for operation, DARE REPRESENTATIVE blanks for which may be obtained from Melvin R. Beer dealers who do not carefuly watch the tops of the bottles they buy, may be in for some bad trouble on and after May first, when the new tax crown law goes into effect. The State of North Carolina collects a tax per bottle and beer brought in from other states, or from anywhere, not having the State government seal on the crowns, is subject to confisca-

Persons selling beer after the 15th of May, who have not filed application to the board and paid their license, will be prosecuted. All old licenses, no matter at what time they were bought, expire on April 30th.
