DOG TALKS

First Aid For Rover

If your pet has an accident, your knowledge of first aid can mean the difference between keeping and losing him. Dogs are prone to accidents with automobiles, yet accidents can range from garden chemical poisoning to burns from a barbecue.

Here are some common sense tips from the dog authorities at the Purina Pet Care Center in St. Louis that will help in the interval before the veterinarian arrives.

- Place a muzzle around the dog's jaws since injured dogs sometimes react with hostility.
- Any excessive bleeding should be controlled by a pressure bandage or pressure applied to the open vessel.
- If there is danger of broken bones, move him gently onto a board which can be an excellent stretcher.
- Burns should first be covered with clothes soaked in cold water, then covered with ointment or coated with towels.

If you suspect a dog has swallowed poison, you can induce vomiting by mixing a half teaspoon of powdered mustard made into a paste with warm water and giving it to him. If an injured dog will drink, always offer lukewarm water with a small quantity of salt in it. This will help reduce the shock which often follows accidents.
