## British Holding Lines Against Teuton Attacks

With the Eritish Armies in France, March 22.-The Bri tish troops are holding the Germans everywhere and driving them back along some parts of the line, the latest reports indi cate.

The Germans began their long advertised offensive yesterday attaziking in tremendous force.

At least nineteen divisions of the enemy have been iden tified in the attack.

By noon yesterday they had succeeded in penetrating the first and second trench defense system.

At five o'clock in the afternoon they delivered a power ful blow on the northwest front but the machine gun fire mow ed down the advancing columns and checked the advance
