### CIRCUMSTANTIAL EVIDENCE

The prisoner's master, Mr. Brunell, deposed as to the sending of Jenkins for the change of a guinea, and to the waiter's having brought back to him a marked one; in the room of the one he had given him unmarked. He also gave evidence as to the recovery of the purse and guineas on the prisoner.
