

ARRIVAL OF THE WASHINGTON.

FOUR DAYS LATER FROM EUROPE. WAR IMMINENT BETWEEN RUSSIA & TURKEY.

NEW YORK, Sept. 29.—The steamer Washington, with London and Southampton dates of the 14th, and Liverpool of the 13th, arrived at 3 o'clock P. M.

The steamer America reached Liverpool on the 11th. Mr. Soule would be received at the Court of Admiralty.

THE EASTERN QUESTION. The London Times, of the 14th, announces that the Czar had rejected the Vienna proposal.

TURKEY. The Porte has contracted for 300,000 winter coats for its troops.

ENGLAND. The cholera was progressing in England. The Marce Polo had arrived at Liverpool from Australia with £280,000 in gold.

FRANCE. The statement that the government was purchasing corn was again officially denied.

ITALY. A council of war at Milan had sentenced 64 persons implicated in the insurrection of Feb. 6th—20 being condemned to die, and the others to confinement in irons for twenty years and less.

PERIA. The city of Jephah had been nearly destroyed by an earthquake.

HUNGARY. The lost jewels of the Hungarian Crown had been found buried near Orshova.
