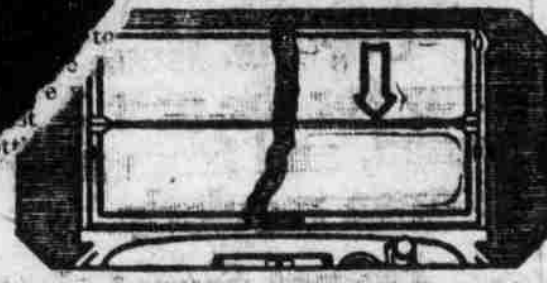
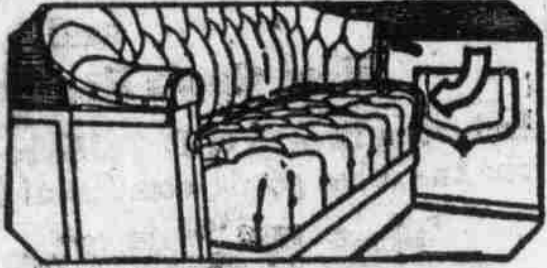


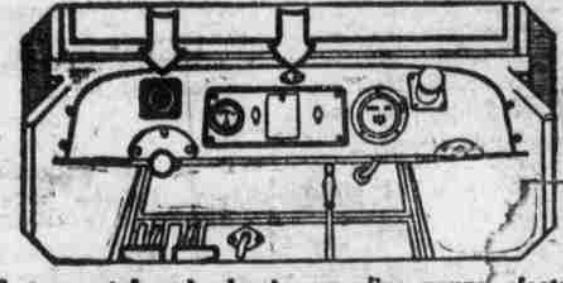
New Refinements



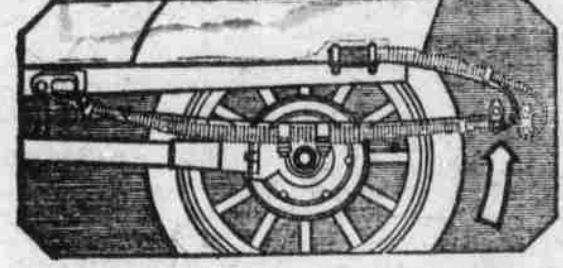
Arrow points to new and improved windshield. Upper half overlaps lower half. Absolutely rain-tight.

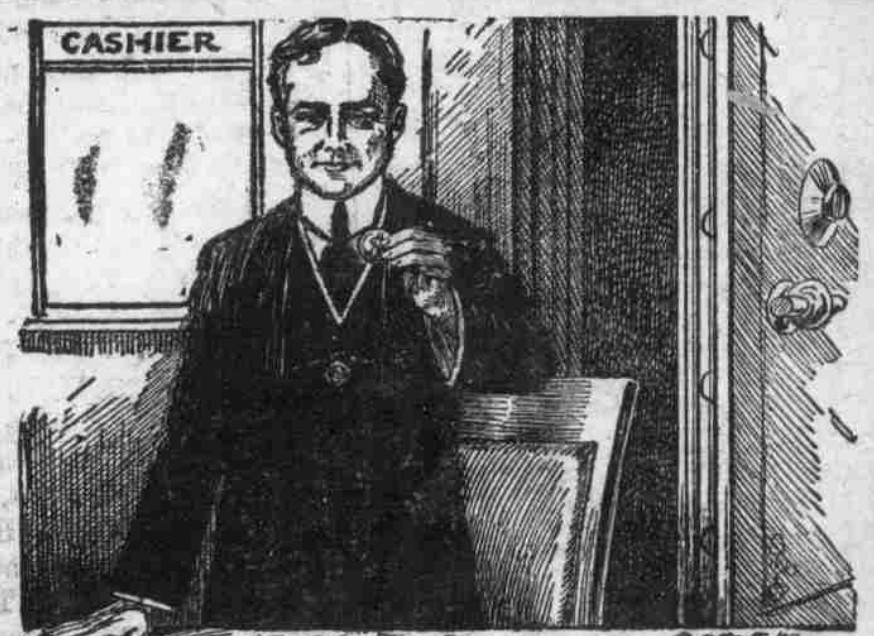
