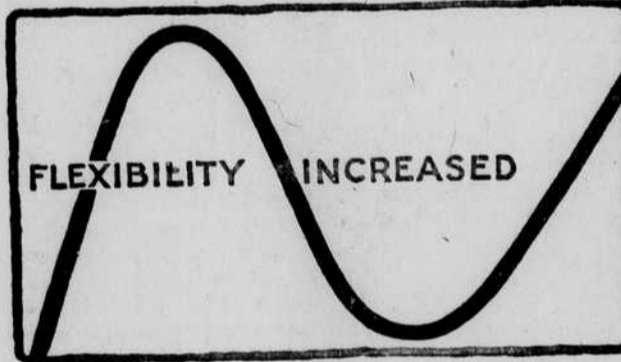

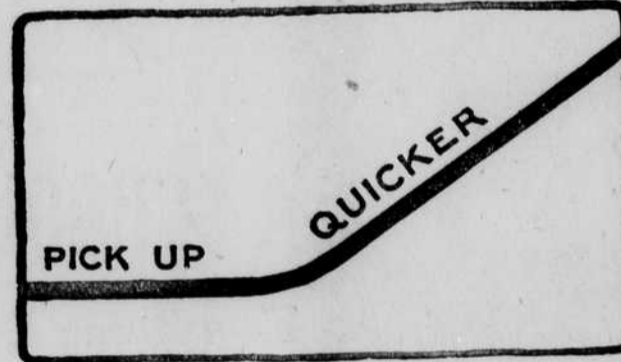
The bidder at such sale will be required to deposit as much as 10 per cent of the amount of his bid as guaranty of good faith, pending confirmation.

The Trustee reserves the right to reject any and all bids, and to postpone the sale from time to time as may be necessary or advisable.

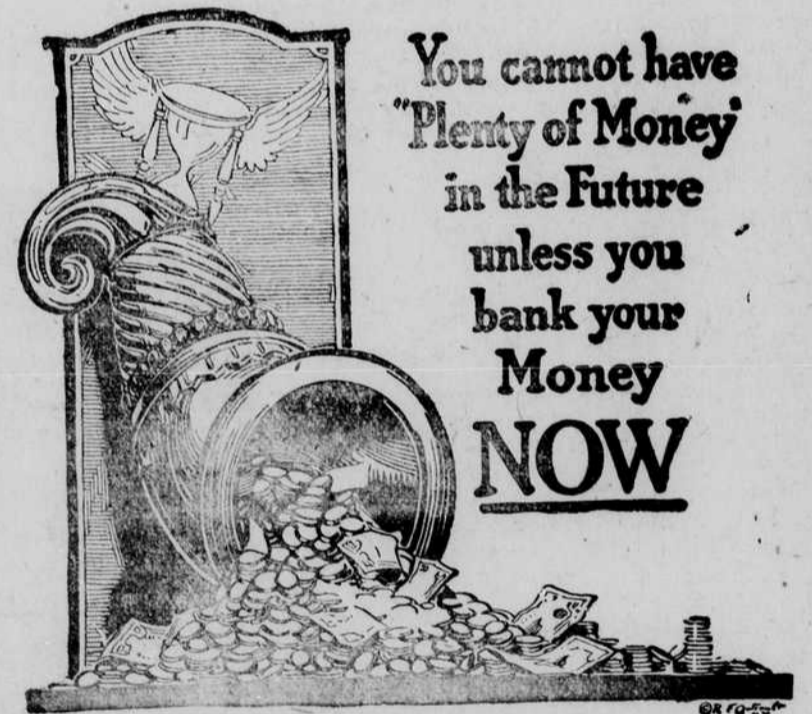
