Melt chocolate over hot water add butter, stir until butter melts, and set aside. Beat eggs, add sugar gradually sift flour and add to eggs with nutmeats and vanilla. Then add chocolate mixture. Spread in shallow greased pan and bake 15 or 20 minutes in a moderate oven, then cut in 2 inches squares while warm.

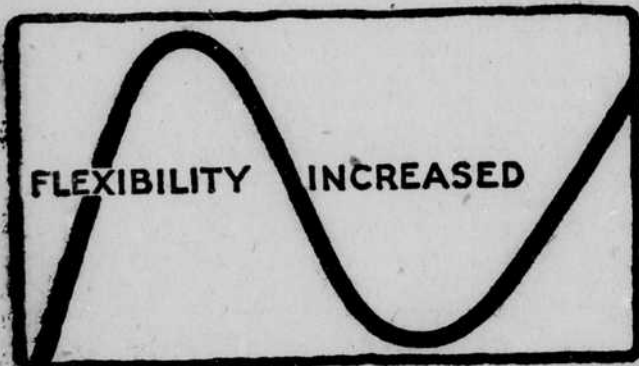

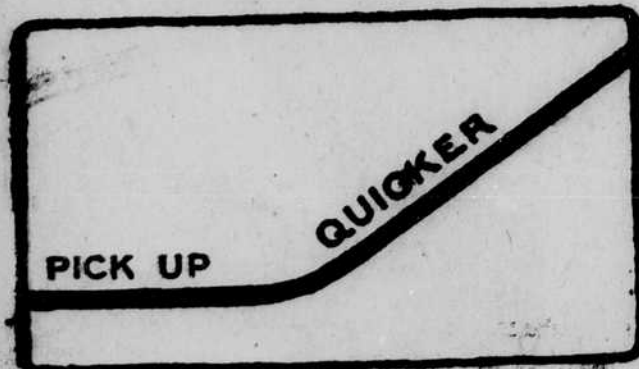
