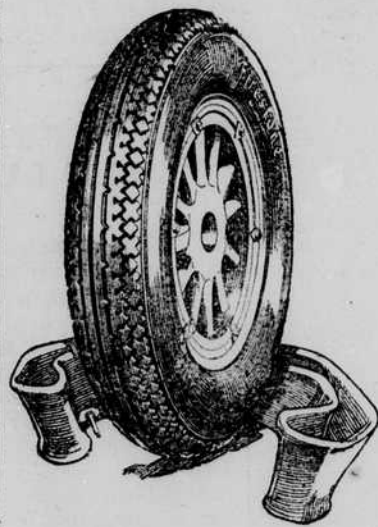
Fashion Hint

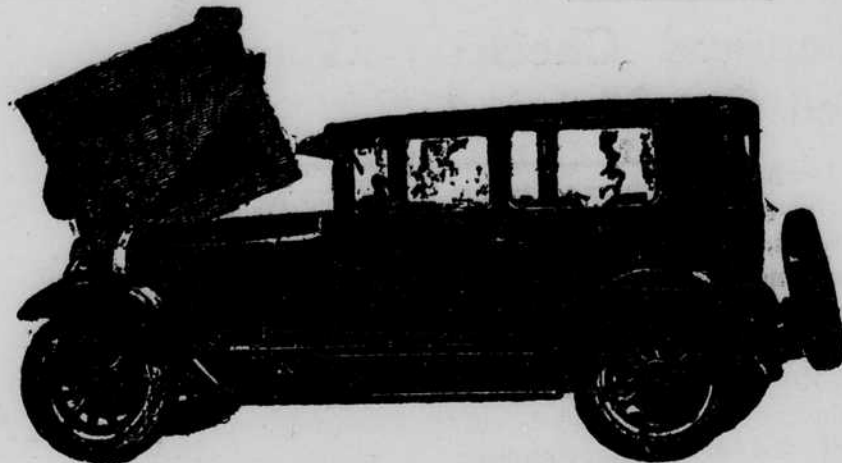
