to be held in line along with other commodity figures, we guess the average is a fair one," one farmer declared in voicing the sentiment among those farmers questioned about the new price figure for the current crop.

It could not be learned immediately what price range if any would be allowed. Last year, it will be recalled that the price range hardly ever went over 60 cents a pound, but that tobacco of any quality whatever sold way up in the thirties and was fairly stable in the forty-cent range.

In addition to the weighted average of 41 cents per pound for auction sales, the agency established a maximum price of five cents a pound for scrap tobacco, but such purchases are to be included when the average for the season is determined. While the preliminary announcement is not quite clear in many details, it is understood that some of the better types of scrap may be sold on the auction floors and will not come under the \$5 price regulation fixed for scrap tobacco.

No Expiration Dates for 'B' and 'C' Gas Coupons

Holders of 'B' and 'C' supplemental ration stamps for passenger cars and 'E' and 'R' non-highway uses no longer are required to apply for renewal of their ration at the date specified on the cover of the coupon book. Holders of these supplemental rations may continue to use their stamps until they are exhausted, unless there is a change in the purpose and use to which the vehicle was put at the time the stamps were issued. The expiration date is now the earliest date at which renewal may be made. Persons who run out of stamps prior to the renewal date are in danger of going without, it was stated at the office of the rationing board.

Gasoline Coupons Must Be Endorsed

Users of gasoline, beginning July 22, are liable to lose their gasoline rations if each coupon in their possession is not properly endorsed in ink, Mrs. Sabrie W. Reid, secretary to the Washington County War Price and Rationing Board, reminded them today.

The new policy of coupon endorsements, the secretary said, was taken to assure maximum protection to book holders. Henceforth, motorists will be required to endorse all coupons immediately upon receipt of renewal gasoline rations, so that they will never have unendorsed coupons in their possession.

Endorsement consists of writing in ink on the face of each ration coupon the license number of the vehicle for which the ration was issued and the state in which the car is registered.
