Air Resistance in Tunnels. When a train goes through a tunact the resistance of the air is an im-

portant factor, experiments having demonstrated that it measures 13.86 pounds per ion of train weight in the Simplon tunnel, as against only 8.8 pounds in the open air, a difference of over 50 per cent. This is when the train is running at 37 miles an hour in the direction of the ventilating air current; when running in the opposite direction the resistance increases to 20.46 pounds.
