In addition to the flour made for market an increasing amount of work is being done for the farmers of this county, who are now becoming more and more interested in raising their own wheat. And Transylvania farmers are not the only ones who patronize the mill here, for a large amount of grinding is done for Henderson County farmers.

When the new motor is put in order the Burnette & Verdery Milling Co. will be prepared to take care of a large part of the milling for Western North Carolina. Their plant is equipped with an American Angleo Mill than which there is no better piece of machinery made for the purpose of making flour. However the output of this plant is not confined to the production of flour. It turns out corn meal, rye flour, shorts and bran.
