Milas Hill of Flat Rock, who is somewhat perturbed by the surgar shortage in this country has decided to start a show of his own. He is raising the sugar beet to beat the band. Recently he sent a sample of the sugar beet he had grown to the agricultural department at Washington with a request that the proper authorities dissect the beet, diagnose the contents and let him know if there was enough sugar in that variety of beet to justify his raising sugar beets on a large scale.
